

Baby Monitor & Alarm – user guide

Main functions of Baby Monitor & Alarm

Baby Monitor & Alarm can run in 2 different modes, each mode will help you in different cases:

- **Baby Alarm** will help you babysit your child. You can leave your iPhone with running Baby Monitor & Alarm in the room where your child is sleeping. When a noise is detected in the room, the iPhone will automatically call a specified number (your second mobile phone or phone of your wife/husband).
- **Baby Monitor** will help you keep track of what is happening in your child's room at night. Does baby sleep the whole night without waking up? Or does your child wake up in the middle of the night? With the Baby Monitor function, you can simply check this. You can also compare “Activity logs” for several nights to check on the sleeping patterns of your child.



Both modes of Baby Monitor & Alarm can be highly configured to fit your needs as well as your child's needs (see Settings chapter).

How to use Baby Alarm

Before first usage

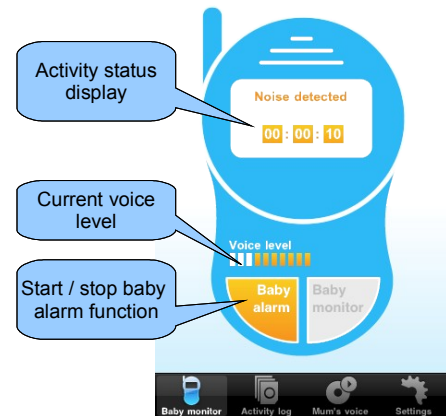
Before you use the Baby Alarm for the first time, you have to set up some basic settings. The only setting, you have to really set up is the phone number that the Baby Monitor & Alarm will call, when it detects a noise in the child's room. You should also set up the sensor sensitivity feature of the application to the voice level of your child, depending on your child's needs.

You can find those settings in the Settings tab of Baby Monitor & Alarm. More detailed descriptions of all settings will be described in a separate chapter below.



Typical use of Baby Alarm

To use Baby Alarm functionality, please start Baby Monitor & Alarm application by putting your iPhone about 1 – 2 meters away from your baby and then press “Baby Alarm” button. You will see on the Activity status display, that voice monitoring has started and actual voice level is displayed as well. Depending on your settings, you can also see the message: “Time to leave room” there. This means that the noise sensor will be turned off for a few seconds/minutes to allow you to leave the room without triggering the alarm. We will discuss this further in the Settings chapter.



Notes / Recommendations:

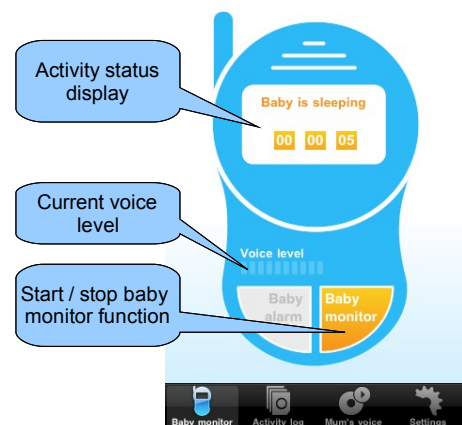
- **Don't switch your iPhone to sleep mode!** Because of iPhone limitations, the alarm cannot be activated when your iPhone is in sleep mode. The iPhone display has to be turned on when using the Baby Alarm.
- We recommend that you attach your iPhone to a power socket to avoid draining the battery of your iPhone.
- We recommend that you switch your iPhone to **silent mode** (using the iPhone silent switch) or set up call forwarding to another phone– so that no incoming calls will disturb your child.
- Check, that you entered the correct “Alarm” number (the phone number that will be called when a noise is detected in the room), into the application, and make sure that you always have your second mobile phone with you.
- Baby Alarm was designed to help you with babysitting. It is not a substitute for human care!

How to use Baby Monitor

To use Baby Monitor functionality, please start Baby Monitor & Alarm application by putting your iPhone about 1 – 2 meters away from your baby and then press “Baby Monitor” button. You will see on the Activity status display, that voice monitoring has started, and the actual voice level is displayed as well.

You can switch your iPhone to sleep mode (so that the display will not be turned on). Monitoring works perfectly even when your iPhone is in sleep mode.

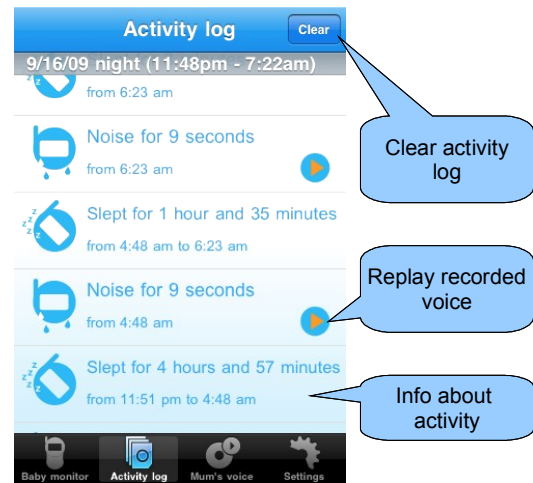
You can display and replay your child's activity in the room, while you were away, by using the Activity Log.



Activity Log

In the activity log, Baby Monitor & Alarm logs all activity while Baby Alarm or Baby Monitor is running. You will have a recording of exactly what was happening while your child was sleeping. The Activity log has unlimited size, so that you can keep records from several nights of your child's sleeping activity. We also record your child's voice from every activity, so that you can replay it just clicking on the Play button.

If you want to clear the Activity Log, please click on Clear button.

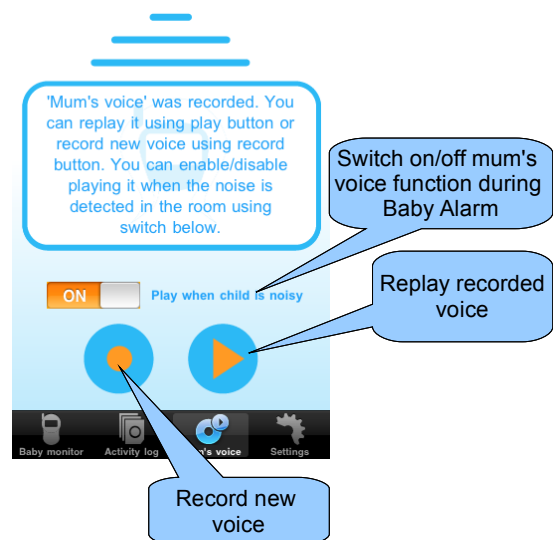


Mum's voice

One of the unique Baby Monitor & Alarm features is Mum's voice. Using this (optional) feature you can record your child's favorite voice (song sung by mum, short rhyme etc.). When enabled, this voice is replayed while Baby Alarm is running – when a noise is detected. If it will not help make your child sleep again, then the alarm will be activated.

If you want to use this feature, you have to record a voice first. Please click on Record button and record the voice that you want your child to hear later on. We recommend that you place your iPhone very near to the source of the voice, so that the recorded voice is clear and loud enough for the child to hear.

After recording the voice, you can replay it to check if the recording is fine by using the play button. To activate the Mum's voice feature with the Baby Alarm, enable it on this screen by using the “play when child is noisy” switch.



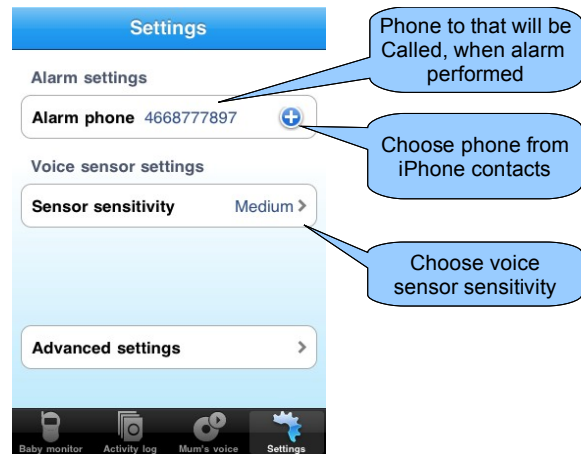
Baby Monitor & Alarm Settings

We implemented many settings in our application to enable you to customize it according to your needs as well as your child's needs. In this chapter, we will go through all of them.

Basic settings

On basic settings tab, you can configure the most important options for Baby Monitor & Alarm:

- **Alarm phone** – please enter phone number that will be called, when a noise is detected while using Baby Alarm function. You can use “+” button to select a phone number from your iPhone contacts directory.
- **Sensor sensitivity** – you can choose from one of 3 levels of sensor sensitivity. Low sensor sensitivity means, that quiet noise will be ignored. High means, that application will work with even quiet noises. Optimal sensor sensitivity depends on iPhone position during monitoring, and we recommend testing this setting before using Baby Monitor & Alarm on your child.
- **Advanced settings** – this option will bring you to the Advanced settings screen

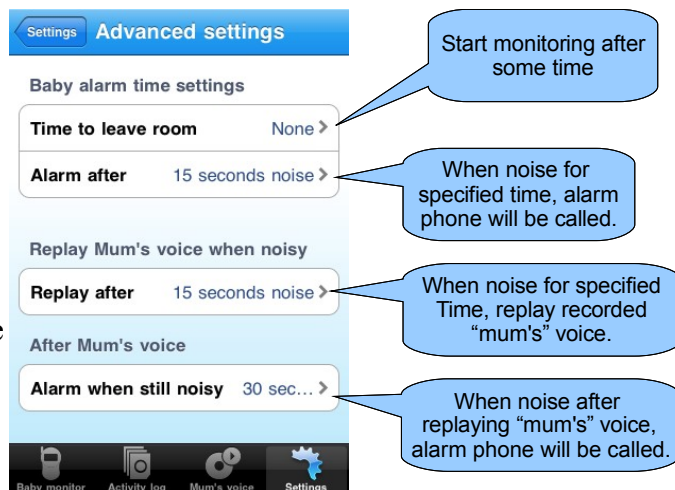


Advanced settings

In advanced settings, you can select the alarm time for your Baby Alarm. This is extremely useful to fit your needs as well as your child's needs.

Advanced settings options description:

- **Time to leave room** – you start your Baby Alarm, say “sweet dreams” to your baby and shut the door. But – you probably don't want to monitor those noises – record them or even trigger the alarm with them. So, we have a countdown default of 15 seconds after the Baby Alarm or Baby Monitor is started. You can change the default countdown, – you can even disable it.
- **Alarm after** – there are different kinds of noises - you probably don't want to start the alarm if your child coughs once. So, the application monitors the noise for some time and after there is still noise for a specified amount of time, the alarm will be activated. It is up to you to set up the time– you can set up a really short time (like 5 seconds), which is probably the best choice for a newborn child. On the other hand, it is better to set up a longer time to



activate the alarm for older children.

- **Replay after** – this option is used only when Mum's voice is set to **ON** on Mum's voice tab (see Mum's voice chapter). Using this option, you can select, when mum's voice will be activated after a specified amount of time.
- **Alarm when still noisy** - this option is used only when Mum's voice is set to **ON** on Mum's voice tab (see Mum's voice chapter). After mum's voice is replayed, the application will still monitor the noise in your child's room. When there is still noise for a specified amount of time, the alarm will be activated. You can set up the time using this option.
